## Conservation Career Opportunities for Youth Grades 8 -12

This program will give students a chance to learn of career opportunities in the conservation field. The Ranger will answer questions on what it is like to work for the National Park Service and will discuss job and internship opportunities available to ages 15 and up through National Parks and partners such as Student Conservation Association and Youth Conservation Corps.



## What is Our Role in Ocean Stewardship? Grades 10 -12

A Ranger will guide students through a facilitated dialogue focused on marine debris as a global ocean issue. Instead of handing out answers the ranger will ask questions aimed to engage students in a meaningful conversation. This program will be supplemented with photo and video content including information. Some setup and participation is required by the teacher.



## Listening to the Ice Grades 5-8

What are global warming and climate change? How are they caused, and how they are impacting our planet? A Ranger will use Kenai Fjords National Park as a looking glass through which to observe our planets health. The ranger will engage students with questions, video content and other techniques in order to broaden their local and global understanding of climate change and leave them with a hopeful attitude about the future of our natural environment.
