Sun-Moon-Earth UV Bead Take-Away



This simple effective take away was invented by ETS member Kate Murphy, Early Childhood Educator at Fontanelle Forest in Nebraska, and shared with the Earth to Sky community for the 2017 Total Solar Eclipse event in the U.S.

Kate remarked, "Our center is also going to use solar beads so I came up with this model that can be hooked to key rings or backpacks." Her source for the "sun" star beads is <u>www.beadtin.com</u>

The beads represent sparkly sun (orange), moon (yellow) and earth (blue). Kate added in UV beads as spacers and strung them together for a fun takeaway reminder of the alignment that makes the eclipse possible.
